

## what is the flagship program?

The Flagship Program is a community-school partnership that enhances the social, academic, cultural and physical achievement of Missoula's youth by creating opportunities that help them to succeed and grow to become healthy and productive adults. It is **FREE** for all Lowell students.

## How do I sign up for the Flagship program?

1. Review the activities available in this brochure to determine which activities are of interest to your child and fit your schedule.
2. Complete the sign-up form and return to the front office, the Flagship office or to your child's teacher. **Priority Deadline is Friday, February 1st**
3. Please note that **for some winter/spring programs, Flagship is split into two sessions.** If you would like to sign your child up for both sessions, please try to sign them up for the same days each session to limit scheduling changes between sessions.
4. If you sign your child up for a class, please make that commitment or let Derek know if you would like to cancel. If your child will be absent, please contact **Derek with The Flagship Program at Lowell at 728-2400 x 4425**
5. A confirmation form will be sent home with your child after sign-up forms have been received. Many classes fill up quickly, and your child may not be registered for every class you list. If your child has been put on the **"Wait List"** this means that the class has filled up. You will be notified if a spot opens up for your child.
6. **Mark your calendars!** After school, your child should meet up with Flagship in the Cafeteria. Children will be directed to their classroom from there. The classroom schedule will be posted on the confirmation form, and your child's teacher will have a schedule.

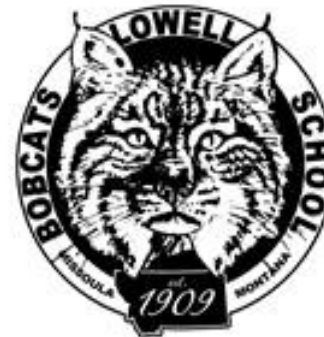

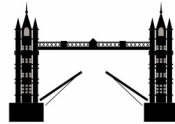
Scale the walls like Spider Man!! Every Friday we will head over to Freestone Climbing Gym and use their awesome rock climbing facility.
