Week 1 – Passport to Fun (Grades K-1)

June 24-28 (9 am-3pm)

Hang on and get your passports punched for fun! This summer Missoula is our true tourist destination. Find yourself at Missoula's splash decks, ice cream parlors, playgrounds, and tennis courts. At each new stop kids will have the chance to get their personal passports punched. With parks, water and tennis on the agenda there's no limit to the fun!

Week 2 – Habitat Heroes (Grades 4-5)

July 1-3 (9 am-3pm)

This week is in collaboration with the Montana DNRC and Missoula Conservation District. No one in Missoula is more qualified to educate our kids in the ways of wildlife! The dynamic nature of this program will bring kids into the field to study our pollinator friends, bugs, and birds. We will also go on excursions to identify native and non-native plants and fish in Milltown State Park and our surrounding ecosystems!

Week 3— Hawks Take the Stage! (Grades 2-3)

July 8-12 (9 am-3pm)

Calling all actors! This week you will develop your skills in play/songwriting, art, singing, dancing, and acting. Students will help write, create and perform in an original musical production by the end of the week.

Week 4 – Outdoor Adventures

(Grades 4-5)

July 15-19 (9 am-3pm)

We will be hiking and touring our way around the Missoula Valley. To cool off, we will be making a few trips to Splash Montana! (snacks/lunch included)

Week 5 – The ART of the Matter (Grades K-1)

July 22-26 (9 am-3pm)

Kids in this program will be taught the important life skill of self expression. Under the experienced instruction of Melissa—our resident Flagship artist—kids will create different art projects using natural objects, paints, charcoal and their imaginations to explore wonderful and original ways to make art. Prepare to learn new things and work in 3D while soaking up the summer sun.

Week 6 – Glorious Garden City (Grades 2-3)

July 28 –Aug 1 (9 am-3pm)

Meet and graze in the gardens of Missoula. Create caring habitats for animals in Hawthorne's backyard. Nurture and harvest plants from our community garden.
